Halepuna Waikiki will temporarily close in response to the Coronavirus

As you may know, the Governor of Hawaii and Mayor of Honolulu have mandated a 14-day self-quarantine for all visitors to the state as well as shelter in place for all individuals in the city of Honolulu effective at 4:30PM on Monday, March 23rd.

As a result, and out of an abundance of caution, it is with a heavy heart that Halekulani Corporation has made the decision to temporarily close Halepuna Waikiki from March 26th to April 30th. Our decision to close temporarily was made solely based upon safeguarding our guests, our staff and our community from COVID-19, and we sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this closure may cause.
